

HOW-TO HALLOWEEN TREAT TUBES

MATERIALS

- Assorted Treat Tubes
- Candy
- Colored Cardstock
- Decorative Halloween Papers
- Scoring Board
- Ribbon
- Raffia
- Washi Tape
- Hot Glue
- Double-Sided Tape
- Double-Sided Foam Adhesive Squares



INSTRUCTIONS

1. To Make the Broom: Fill tubes with candy. Seal shut.
2. Measure length & width of your tube. Cut wood patterned decorative paper to wrap tube. Attach to tube with double-sided tape.
3. Measure raffia in approximately 4-5 in. lengths. Using hot glue stick raffia around bottom of tube (about 1 in. from bottom). When fully wrapped tie with another piece of raffia.
4. Cut a decorative piece of paper & layer it on top of first. Secure together with double-sided tape. Punch hole in top & tie onto tube with raffia.
5. Cut out another decorative piece to layer (we used a bat). Using a double sided adhesive square add to tag to give a 3-D effect.
6. To Make the Rosette: Fill tube of your choice with candy.
7. Adhere decorative paper to bottom of tube with double-sided tape.
8. Cut 2 - 1 1/2 in. strips of orange paper.
9. Place paper on scoring board & score at 1/2 inch intervals.
10. Stick both pieces of paper together using double-sided tape.
11. Fold in an accordion style. Attach both ends together with double-sided tape.
12. Press circle down with your hand to create a rosette.
13. Drop hot glue into the center of the rosette & hold in place until the glue cools & is set.
14. Turn rosette over & hot glue the other side.
15. Cut out an embellishment to cover center glue spot. Hot glue embellishment in place.
16. Cut out a tiny embellishment (we used a spider) & using a foam square stick on top of previous paper. This will give it a 3-D effect.
17. Hot glue a folded piece of sheer ribbon to back of the rosette. Add small strips of Washi tape for color if desired.
18. Hot glue rosette to the front of tube.
19. To Make the Pumpkin Tube: Fill tube of your choice with candy.
20. Seal top of tube with washi tape.
21. Add a matching piece of washi tape to the bottom of the tube leaving a 1/4 in. space.
22. Cut out a decorative piece of paper & wrap it around middle section of the tube with a border facing down. Secure with double-sided tape.
23. Flip that piece of paper around & leaving a 1 1/2 inch space glue on the same style of paper with the border facing up. Secure with double-sided tape.
24. Cut out a pumpkin shape from a decorative piece of paper. Glue a stem on top. Using double sided tape stick it to the center space between the two border papers.
25. Cut out another decorative design from paper (we used a spider cut in a flower shape). You can use a punch if you like.
26. Cut tiny slits from the edge of your shape almost to the center. Then carefully curl these edges in until it makes a "flower like" shape (ours has a spider in the middle).
