

HOW-TO SUPER HERO PILLOWS

MATERIALS

- Fabric Panels from Robert Kaufman – Superhero Collection
- Contrasting Solid Fabrics
- Mountain Mist Fiberfill Stuffing



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut panels from Superhero fabric leaving 1/4 seam around each print.
2. Cut backing for each print to be at least 1 – 1 ½ inches bigger around each side of print. Cut a back for pillow also.
3. Press edges of print under to backside of fabric.
4. Pin into place on top of fabric back. Top stitch in place.
5. Pin back of pillow to top with right sides facing. Sew around edges leaving a small opening at bottom of pillow to insert stuffing.
6. Turn right sides out.
7. Press. Stuff.
8. Sew the opening shut by hand.
9. Repeat on as many of the Superhero panels as you wish.
